


#### Rummage Sale 2021

# Rummage News

The Rummage Sale of St. Mary's has a motto: "Christ has no body but yours..." -St. Teresa of Avila. When parishioners donate, items support dozens of ministries, both in and out of this parish. When contributions begin arriving in January, volunteers sort, clean and distribute, looking for the best place each item can be put to use.

You might be surprised to learn where your donations go. At least 3 ministries within the parish rely on the Rummage Barn. Baby clothing, blankets, car seats, carriers, furniture for infants go to the Gabriel project. Friends of St. Vincent de Paul are sometimes brought over to shop during the year, when they need appliances, furniture, or clothing. Notebooks and books are taken by the Altar Society and given to retired priests for their visits. Extra special items, worthy of our bazaar auctions, are sent to the bazaar committees, as well as baskets that are then filled and displayed. New or gently used toys supply the kid zone and other booths at the bazaar.

At least a dozen ministries outside of our parish benefitted this year. Men's suits and dress shoes went to a sober living house to be used for job interviews. Stuffed animals were sent to a battered woman shelter, blankets and jewelry went to a local nursing home, yarn was made into blankets and donated to a children's hospital, rosaries, religious medals and items went to a Pro-Life Outreach for ladies in crisis. A local St. Vincent de Paul ministry was able to furnish their offices. Used blankets and towels were delivered to a local dog shelter. Boxes of items were sent to Louisiana after the hurricanes devastated their area.

What happens with everything that still remains? We sell it at a reduced price so that anyone in our community that has a need can make purchases on the day of our wonderful rummage sale. The Rummage Sale made a nice profit for St. Mary's with the items we were unable to give to other charities. And, that is amazing. It's been said before, but we heard it countless times from visitors from other parishes, "You have so many volunteers from your parish! We don't have that." We count ourselves fortunate to have the support, dedication, and volunteers willing to work countless hours for our Rummage Sale. The volunteers make it a truly amazing event.

If you feel called to work in the rummage sale ministry, call Lauren Twining. Or, just show up on Wednesdays to the rummage barn in Jan. We are always in need of volunteers. There is no time commitment, work when you can. And, start saving your items, we will begin accepting donations soon!


